

Road Accidents in India




- 1,317 Accidents and 413 Persons killed every day
- 55 Accidents and 17 Persons killed Every Hour

86.5% of total number of Road Accidents accounted by 13 States (2016)




Cities with Higher Road Accidents

- ❖ We have to emphasize, day after day, that the Child/student must look both ways exiting the bus, car, motorcycle, bicycle and crossing roads.




Road and Traffic Safety Day
